**Objective:** To evaluate the association between overweight/obesity and multidrug resistance in patients with and without a history of tuberculosis treatment.

**Materials and methods:** Cross-sectional study conducted through a secondary analysis of a tuberculosis cohort database, with data from anthropometric tests and drug susceptibility tests at the baseline visit of patients with and without prior tuberculosis treatment.


**Results:** A total of 3,734 new cases and 766 with a history of tuberculosis treatment were evaluated. Overweight/obesity was not.


